Solidarity for Human Rights in Iran

Campaign to Save the Lives of Zaniar and Loghman Moradi

January 19th and 20th 2013

During the UN General Assembly's meeting on the 20th of December, 2012, a majority voted to condemn human rights violations in Iran and state repression against defenders of human rights. This is not the first time that condemnation has been issued against the Islamic Republic after reviewing its terrible record.

The Islamic Republic was condemned in this resolution for blatant human rights violations, crackdown against dissidents and political activists, torture of those engaged in civil disobedience as workers, teachers, students, women, and minorities. We would like to bring attention to the Islamic Republic's retaliatory efforts in light of this condemnation. At this moment a large number of civil and political activists are awaiting execution in prison cells.

In our previous statement, as a network, we expressed our concern at the Islamic Republic's reaction to the resolution. A large number of executions of political prisoners, the conviction of death for five Arab-Iranian activists at the hands of the Supreme Court and death sentences for Zaniar and Loghman Moradi, two Iranian Kurds, reaffirm our concerns and reinforce the need for solidarity and action worldwide to prevent these executions in Iran.

Zaniar and Loghman Moradi, Jaber Alboushoukeh, Mokhtar Alboushoukeh, Hadi Rashedi, Hashem Shabaninejad, Mohammad Ali Amourinejad and other political prisoners have denied all charges and stated that confessions were extracted from them under duress and after months in solitary confinement.

We warn human rights organizations, governments, world public opinion, and political groups and parties of the imminent danger facing Iranian political prisoners, especially Zaniar Moradi, Loghman Moradi, Jaber Alboushoukeh, Mokhtar Alboushoukeh, Hashem Shabaninejad, Mohammad Ali Amourinejad, Rezgar (Habib) Afshari, Ali Afshari, Gholamreza Khosravi-Soadjani, Habibollah Golparipour and Habibollah Latifi.
